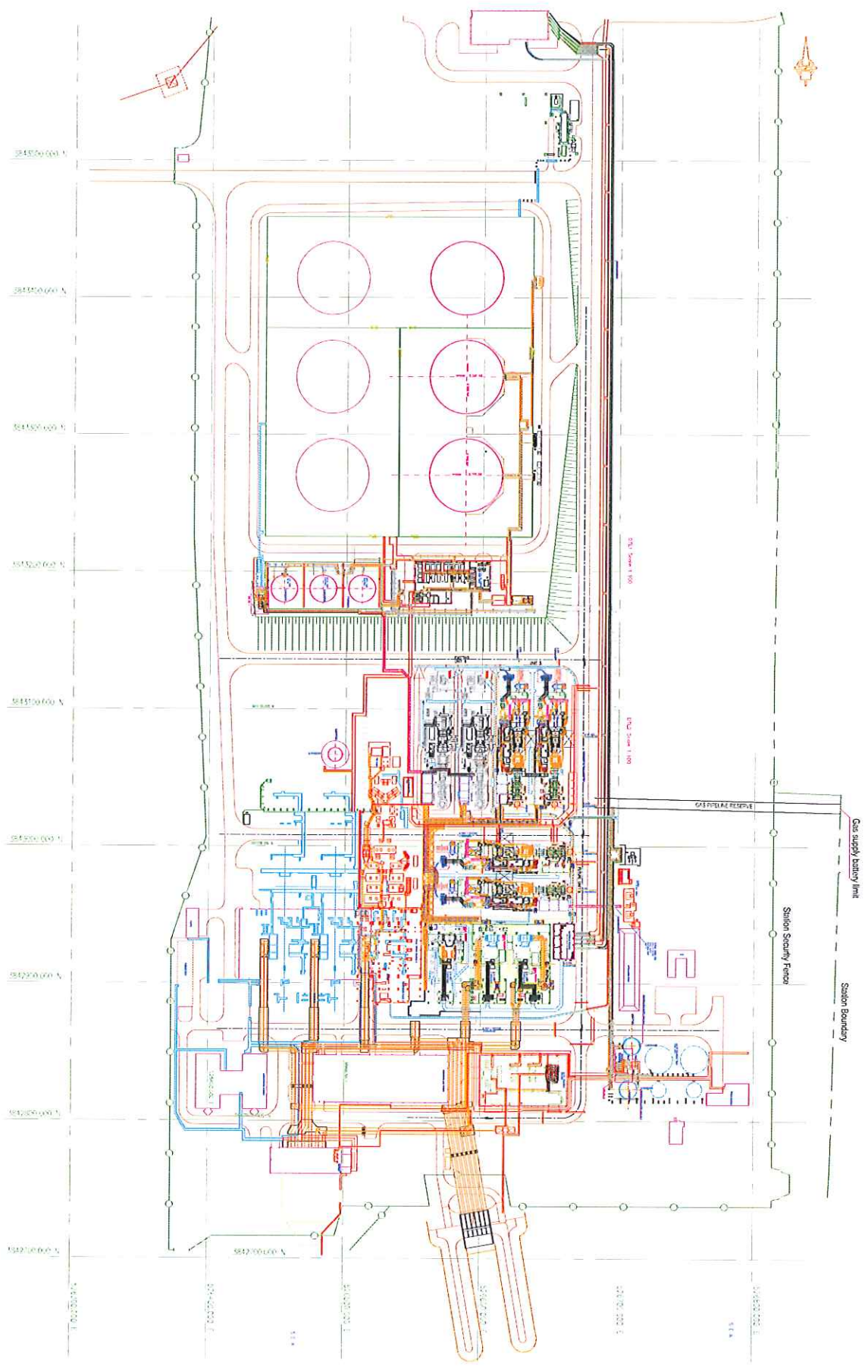

### **CLARIFICATION No. 1** **8 OCT 2012**

Following several Questions received, the following Clarifications are issued:

1. The maximum size of the files that can be received via E-mail is 5MB. Please avoid sending files larger than 5MB on the same e-mail.
2. A map showing the precise location of gas delivery at the power plant fence is attached.

4. At the Electricity Authority of Cyprus (EAC) delivery point the minimum pressure should be 35 barg and the maximum pressure should not exceed 70 barg.

5. DEFA will be able to provide “credit support” arising from a Back to Back SPA Agreement with EAC who will be the sole customer of DEFA.
6. Paragraph 5.2.5 d (iii) is part of 5.2.5 d (ii). The two points are to be merged into the same paragraph.
7. The reference to Solid Alternative Fuel Guarantees under CPs, means “firm” guarantees and is not related to Coal or Wood.
8. A word document of the Pro Forma Response Letter and the CA, as described in Appendix C and D has been uploaded on our webpage ([www.defa.com.cy](http://www.defa.com.cy)) under Tenders Section.
9. DEFA is the sole importer and distributor of Natural Gas in Cyprus and it is DEFA who will be the importer of Gas.
10. Two CCGT Units, 220MW each can switch to Natural Gas within 6 months. Another 3 (130MW each) Steam units can be converted within 18 months. All abovementioned Units are located at Vasilikos.
11. Under EU Directives the Cyprus Gas Market is classified as an isolated and Emerging Market and DEFA was granted a 10 year monopoly in the distribution of Natural Gas within Cyprus starting from the day of first import of Natural Gas
12. The role of CERA is described under paragraph 2.2.2.
13. As stated in the Expression of Interest document detailed selection criteria will be notified to selected parties before the commencement of the next stage. As also noted in the EOI document of paramount importance are the time of arrival of Natural Gas, the Price and the Guarantees offered.
14. Any Agreement regarding the supply of gas should start as soon as possible and last until 30.09.2018 irrespective of whether indigenous gas is available before 30.09.2018. In case indigenous gas is not available by 30.09.2018 this agreement will probably be extended up to the time that indigenous gas is available for use.
15. The building of suitable storage, if such infrastructure is necessary, is the responsibility of the interested party.
16. Cost of building Regasification ships or any other necessary infrastructure is the responsibility of the interested party.
